Ministerial Order No.3520, dated November 12th,1930,
concerning the formation of a Committee to
undertake the organization of courses of
public lectures for ladies in
general.

The Minister of Education,

Having considered that it is necessary to respond to the
needs of the feminine movement in the country by providing, without
any delay, facilities for ladies in general to widen the scope of
their attainments and to acquire a fair share of the general
culture which is connected with their social life, and which
will enable them satisfactorily to undertake the duties and
responsibilities imposed upon them;

Seeing that, in order to realise the above aim, a committee
should be constituted to organise courses of public lectures for
ladies in general on subjects connected with Hygiene, Ethics, Arts,
History and, in short, all social subjects, the lectures on which
will tend to secure for the ladies who attend them the benefit
to be expected from this feminine movement;

hereby orders as follows:-

Art.1. A Committee shall be constituted in the Ministry
of Education, and shall be composed of:-

Art. 2. This Committee shall undertake the organisation of courses of public lectures for ladies in general so that the aims referred to in this order may be realised.

Art. 3. The Under-Secretary of State for the Ministry of Education is entrusted with the execution of this Order which should come into force from the date of its issue.
